Maundy Thursday (April 13) 7:00 PM in the sanctuary; a service of sharing communion and reflecting on all that communion means.

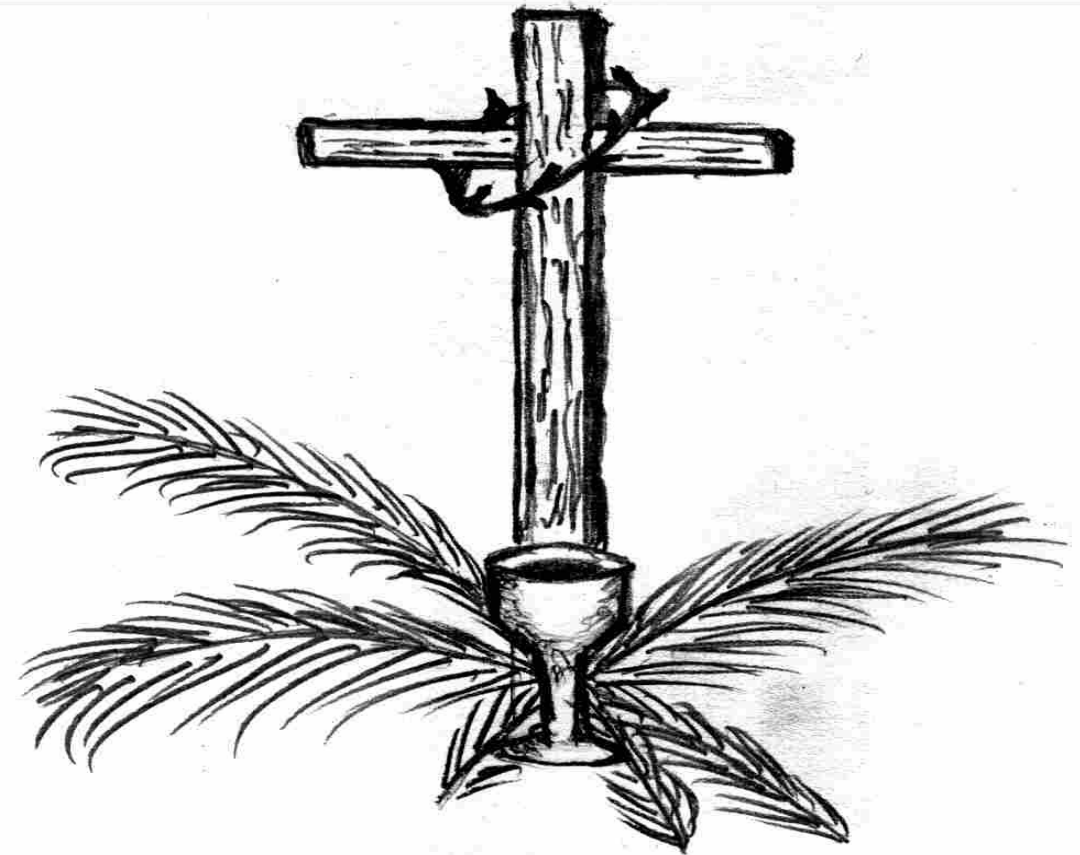
Good Friday (April 14) 12:00 Noon in the sanctuary; a service of meditation.
