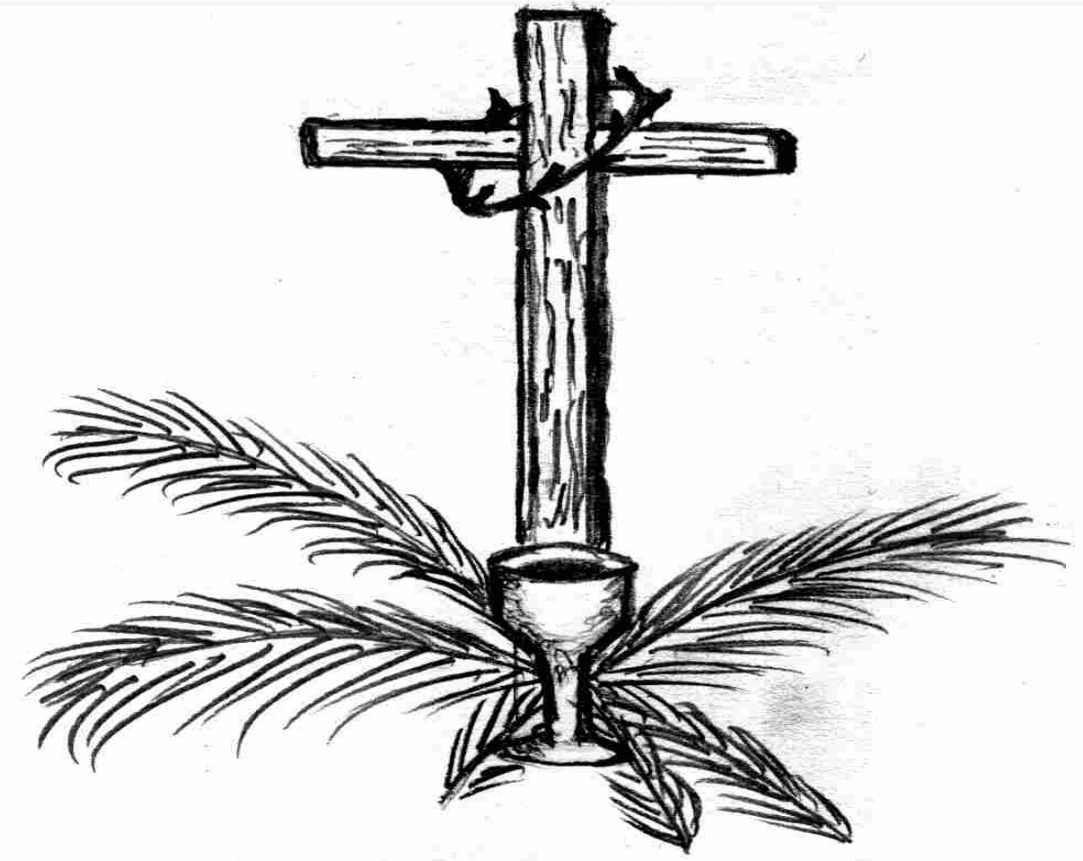
ANNOUNCEMENTS
