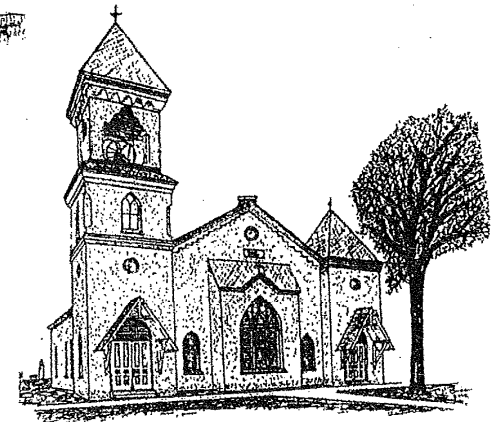
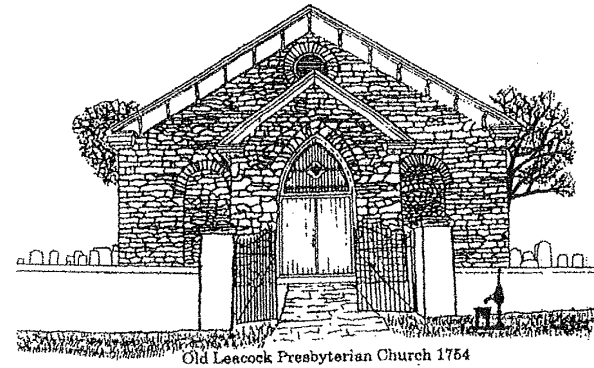

his championship form. It is an enjoyable night for all. Everyone can purchase an ice cream treat after the games, win or lose. Hope to see many people there!

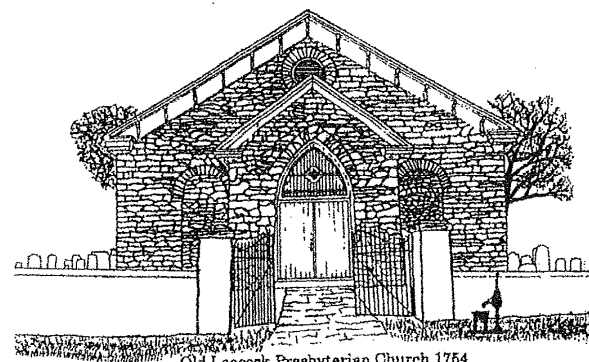
Share the Bounty
